File taken up today on an application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Aman Ansari**.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is in JC since 05.12.2025 and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that as per the FIR is concerned the amount allegedly looted is stated to be Rs. 1,36,000/- which the complainant claims to have received from a party in Gandhi Nagar where he had gone to collect the money. It is further submitted that the complainant further stated that the said amount counted by him at the time of receiving. It is further submitted that at a later stage he improved and mentally changed his version stating that the amount in the pithu bag was Rs. 36,00,000/- instead of Rs. 1,36,000/- such a drastic variation in the alleged amount make the complainant's statement high contradictory. It is further submitted that applicant/accused has nothing to do with the present complaint. It is further submitted that all recovery as well as the infliction of

the knife was not done by the applicant/accused as he was not present at the time of place of incident. It is further submitted that no application of applicant/accused is pending either before any other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Briefly stated, the present FIR bearing no. 953/2025 has been registered at PS Jahangir Puri U/s. 310(2) / 311 / 317(3) / 61(2)/3(5) BNS. The allegations against applicant/accused **Aman Ansari** are that he alongwith his co-accused persons, in furtherance of their common intention, committed robbery of cash amounting to Rs. 36,00,000/- and while committing the aforementioned robbery accused persons caused multiple stab injuries to the victim. As per the reply of IO, cash amounting to Rs. 1,40,000/- out of the robbed money amounting to Rs. 36

lakhs and a motorcycle used in commission of the alleged offences were recovered from the possession of applicant / accused **Aman Ansari**. Present case is at initial stage charge has not been framed as yet. Further, eye-witnesses are yet to be examined. Releasing applicant/accused **Aman Ansari** may cause serious threats to the eye witnesses.

Keeping in view of the above discussion and seriousness of allegations leveled against applicant/accused **Aman Ansari** as well as keeping in view of seriousness and gravity of the offence alleged against him, this court is not inclined to grant bail to applicant/accused **Aman Ansari**. Bail application is accordingly, dismissed.

Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion the merits of the case. **Copy of order be given dasti to the concerned parties.** The present bail application file be tagged with the main case file.
