1. Today, it is jointly submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the parties that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and a consent decree be passed.
2. In order to show the settlement and bonafide of D2 the defendant has placed on record three cheques bearing no. 366742, dt 25.08.2026 of amount of Rs. 100000/- pertaining to Indian Overseas Bank, Cheque bearing number 366744, dt. 21.10.2026 of amount of Rs. 300000/- pertaining to Indian Overseas Bank and Cheque bearing number 366746, dt. 19.12.2026 of amount of Rs. 600000/- pertaining to Indian Overseas Bank issued in favor of plaintiff respectively.
3. It is submitted by defendant that he will abide by the terms of the settlement and the cheque will be honored on presentation on the respective dates. Per contra, Ld. Counsel for plaintiff submits that the case CC NI Act 2143/25 pending in the court of Ld. JMFC Sh. Gaurav Dahiya, NI Act, North, Rohini will be withdrawn by the plaintiff after the entire payment has been received by the plaintiff on 19.12.2026.
4. Heard. Considered.
5. I have gone through the material placed on record and personally inquired from the respective parties i.e. plaintiff

and defendant. I am of the view that the settlement has been arrived without any coercion and any undue influence. Further, I am also convinced that in the present matter the consent decree can be passed without any hindrance.

6. Ergo, in view of the aforesaid, the consent decree be passed.
7. Separate statement of the plaintiff and defendant be recorded in this regard
8. Needless to state that the parties must conform with the terms and conditions adumbrated above without any failure and in case of failure that law will take its own course.
9. Accordingly, consent decree be passed and the present suit is disposed of as settled.
10. The entire court fees be refunded to plaintiff as per rules.
