

10 MISC DJ 1358/25 CHAMELI DEVI AND ORS. Vs. UNION
OF INDIA AND ORS. (EX.)

The application is for the restoration of the execution petition which was disposed off as satisfied on 25.07.2025. The Counsel for the DH states that as per his calculation, the award amount was of Rs.2,94,078/-. However, a lesser payment of Rs.1,78,162.85 was deposited in the Court, which led to the disposal of the execution as satisfied. Even in the report of the District Nazir, the due amount was mentioned as Rs.2,94,078/- and despite this, a short payment of Rs.1,78,162.85 was deposited in the Court.

In these circumstances, issue notice to the LAC concerned as well as to JD No. 2 DUSIB on filing of PF returnable for **23.01.2026**, to explain, as to why a lesser payment was deposited in the Court, though the warrants of attachment was issued for the entire award amount @ Rs.2,94,078/-.
