**ORDER BELOW BAIL APPLICATION**

This is an application for bail moved by the accused under section 437 of the Cr. P. C. in connection with C. R. No. 352/2023 registered with Mumbai Central railway police station for the offence punishable under section 411 of the I. P. C.

2. Read the application. Accordingly, say of Ld. A. P. P. was called. The Ld. A. P. P. has filed his say and objected the application. The Ld. A. P. P. has submitted that say filed by the I. O. may be considered.

3. Heard the Ld. Counsel Shri. Kiran Rane for the accused. Admittedly, the offence is non bailable, but not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. It is alleged that, the accused has purchased stolen Mobile phone of the informant without box and bill. The Mobile phone is recovered. Chargesheet is also filed against the accused. There is no material on the record to show that the accused is habitual offender.

4. Having regard to the nature of offence and stage of the case, if bail is granted subject to certain conditions no harm or prejudice would be caused to the prosecution. Hence, I pass the following order :-

**ORDER**

1. The Bail application No. 221 of 2025 is allowed and disposed

of.

2. Accused namely Uttam Khushal Chavan is released on bail on executing his P. R. Bond of Rs.7,500/- (Seven thousand Five hundred) with local surety of the like amount.
3. Accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and shall not make contact with any person known to the facts of the case and attend each and every date of hearing, till conclusion of trial.
4. Accused shall submit authenticated copy of his identity and address proof.
5. Accused shall not indulge himself in the same kind of offence here-in-after.
6. Provisional cash bail of Rs. 10,000/- (Seven thousand Five hundred) is allowed for Four weeks.

2. Read the application. Accordingly say of Ld. A. P. P. and I.O. was called. I. O failed to filed his say. Hence, application proceeded without his say. Ld. Asst P. P. has submitted that his argument may be treated as heard.

3. Heard Ld. Counsel Shri Atul Pandey for the accused. Admittedly, the offence is not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. It is alleged that the accused has committed theft of mobile phone of the informant. The stolen mobile phone is recovered. Chargesheet is also filed against the accused.

4. Under the circumstances if bail is granted subject to certain conditions no harm or prejudice would cause to the prosecution. Hence, I pass the following order :-

**ORDER**

1. The Bail application No. 248 of 2025 is allowed and disposed of.
2. Accused viz. Suraj Chakrabahadur Damai be released on bail on his executing P. R. Bond of Rs. \_\_\_\_\_/-

3. Accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and shall not make contact with any person known to the facts of the case and attend each and every date of hearing, till conclusion of trial.
