ORDER BELOW BAIL APPLICATION

This is an application for bail moved by accused under section 480 of the B. N. S. S. in connection with C. R. No. 563/2025, registered with Mumbai Central Railway Protection Force, for the offence punishable under section 143 of Indian Railway's Act.

2. Accused crave for bail inter-alia on grounds that, he has been falsely implicated in the said offence and has nothing to do with the alleged offence. That, the investigation is practically done by police and the custodial interrogation of the accused is not required. The accused is not habitual offender. The attendance of the accused can be easily secure. The accused will abide by each and every condition imposed by this court. Hence, prays for bail.

3. Accordingly, say of Ld. P. P. and E.O. was called. Accordingly they have filed their say and objected the application.

4. I have heard the Ld. Counsel Shri H. A. Vora for the accused. He has submitted that, inquiry is utmost completed. Physical custody of accused is not required. Accused is ready to Co-Operate in the inquiry and also ready to abide by each and every condition imposed by this Court.

5. I have gone through the arguments advanced by both sides. Also gone through the remand papers. No physical custody of accused is required for further inquiry. In such circumstance, no purpose would be served by keeping accused behind the bars. In such circumstance, if bail application is allowed thereby imposing

certain conditions, it would meet the ends of justice. Hence, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

1. The Bail application No. 226 of 2025 is allowed and disposed of.
2. Accused viz. Mayur Jain S/o Mangilal Jain be released on bail on his executing P. R. Bond of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with one surety of like amount.
3. Accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and shall not hamper in the enquiry till filing of the complaint or till further order, whichever is earlier.
4. Accused shall pay his appearance before the Enquiry officer as and when required.
5. Accused shall submit authenticated copy of his permanent address proof.
6. Accused shall not indulge himself in the same kind of offence here-in-after.
7. Provisional cash bail of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) is allowed for Four weeks.
8. Office to inform to the accused immediately. Issue letter to the Jail Authority accordingly.
