This is an Action Plan 2026-27 case.

The case is fixed for cross-examination of the complainant. CW is present but could not be examined as Ld. Proxy Counsel for the accused requested for an adjournment on the ground that main counsel for the accused is not available. Heard. Therefore, in the interest of justice, this court has allowed the request of the Ld. Proxy counsel for the accused for cross-examination of complainant, which permits the Court to record the statement of a witness and pass necessary orders where a party or his counsel is absent or not ready to examine/cross-examine a witness.

However, it is expressly clarified that: The accused shall complete the cross-examination of complainant on the next date and if the accused fails to cross-examine complainant on the next date, the Court shall proceed further and may record the witness's evidence as it thinks fit including dispensing with cross-examination in accordance with law. Further, the complainant is also directed to conclude the remaining evidence on the next date at his own responsibility. On request of Ld. Proxy Counsel for the accused, case is adjourned to **31.08.2026** for cross-examination of complainant as well as for remaining complainant evidence.

Further, the Ld. Counsels and parties have been apprised that this being an Action Plan matter, it must be disposed of expeditiously. Consequently, no unnecessary adjournments shall be granted. The parties are directed to ensure timely compliance with all respective directions.
