File taken up today on an application moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Gulzar Ali @ Naseem** seeking waiver of the condition of furnishing the surety and enlarging the applicant on personal bond in FIRNo. 679/2019 U/s. 308/34 IPC PS Bhalaswa Dairy.

Verification report has been received from HC Dinesh Kumar Singh. Perusal of the same shows that applicant/accused **Gulzar Ali @ Naseem** had been residing at 100/2 , Ground Floor, 25 Foota Road, Gali No. 2, Kamal Pur, Kamal Vihar, Burari, Delhi prior to his arrest in the present FIR case and the aforesaid address is his permanent address. Further, statement of mother of applicant/accused is also recorded in this respect.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused was granted bail on 11.09.2025 by this Court subject to furnishing personal bond of Rs. 15,000/- with one surety of like amount. It is further submitted that applicant/accused is an underprivileged person and does not have any contact or person who can give his surety of like

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amount. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

Submissions heard. Record perused.

Applicant/accused is in JC since 11.08.2023 and he has not been able to furnish bailbond, due to poor financial condition despite getting bail vide order dated 11.09.2025, therefore, on humanitarian ground as well as in view of the directions issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in recent case, **it is ordered that applicant/accused be released on personal bond on furnishing before the concerned Jail Superintendent.** Rest of the conditions shall remain as it is. Application stands disposed of. Copy of the order be sent to concerned Jail Superintendent for information and compliance.
