Vide order dated 23.04.2025, the application of the applicant/ plaintiff was allowed under order VI Rule 17 CPC and the amended plaint was taken on record.

Opportunity was also given to the defendant for filing WS. Ld Counsel for the defendant today submits that he do not wants to file any additional WS in view of the formal amendments carried out by the plaintiff. It is further submitted that the WS of the defendants which is already on record be considered.

Accordingly, pleadings are complete. On the basis of pleadings, following issues are framed for trial:

- 1. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the decree for recovery of Rs. 5,75,000/-, as prayed for? OPP*
- 2. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for interest @18% per annum, and if so, for which period and on what amount? OPP*
- 3. Whether the present suit do not discloses any cause of action? OPD*
- 4. Whether the suit has been improperly valued for the purposes of court fees and jurisdiction? OPD.*
- 5. Relief.*

No other issue arises or is pressed for by the parties.
