

State Vs. Deepak

Today the case was fixed for arguments on superdari application. Arguments heard. As per SHO report, the vehicle bearing registration No. HR-35V-7159 is in police possession and police has not raised any objection in releasing the vehicle in question on superdari to its registered owner.

At this stage, Sh. Vikas Ranga, Advocate for applicant has appeared before the court and suffered a statement to the effect that Deepak had purchased the above said vehicle from Mr. Devi Singh in February, 2026, RC of which is registered in his name but Insurance is not transferred in his name.

Heard. It is directed that the vehicle in question be released in favour of its registered owner/SPA holder on execution of superdignama in the sum of Rs.6 lacs with one surety in the like amount alongwith surety on usual terms and conditions of superdari, and subject to satisfaction of concerned SHO who must verify details of ownership, title and papers etc. before releasing vehicle. Same be filed before court. Papers be tagged with main file/FIR.
