Shivpreet Singh vs. State

Present : Ms.Seema Sangowal, Advocate counsel for applicants Shivpreet Singh son of Harpreet Singh and Harpreet Singh son of Baljinder Singh, both residents of Village Boparai Kalan, Tehsil and District Ludhiana.

ORDER:

Ld.Addl.PP has placed on record the report of Incharge of Police Station Sudhar, Ludhiana reflecting that that as per their record, till date neither any application for probe is pending against the applicants nor any FIR has been registered against them so far in the said Police Station. Further, it is report that they are not required in any case so far.

2. Arguments on the bail application for anticipatory bail heard.

3. It is submitted by the applicants as well as argued by their counsel that the SHO/Incharge visited the house of the applicants. Now the Investigating Agency is threatening to involve

them in a criminal case. They have apprehension of being arrested and involved in a false criminal case. They are ready to join the investigation as and when called by the police. A prayer is therefore made for granting anticipatory bail or in the alternative for grant of ad-interim bail in the event of arrest of the applicants or for giving direction to the concerned SHO/IO to issue a 7 days prior notice after registration of any FIR against the applicants.

4. On the other hand, in the report filed by prosecution as well as argued by the learned PP, it is submitted that as per record, till date no FIR/case/complaint is lying pending against the present applicants. While arguing on these lines, the bail application is sought to be dismissed.

5. From the perusal of the file and as discussed above, it is evident that no case/FIR has been registered against the applicants till today with regard to the allegations leveled by them in the present bail application. Hence, it is obvious that till date there is no cognizable matter before Police of Police Station Sudhar, Ludhiana against applicants which might require their arrest in any cognizable, non-

bailable offence. This bail application for anticipatory bail, therefore, has become infructuous and same is accordingly dismissed as such.

6. File be consigned to Record-Room after due compliances.
