This is 3rd bail application for grant of regular bail moved on behalf of the applicant / accused Vishal.

Present : Sh. Harvinder Nar, Ld Addl P.P for the state.
Sh. R. K. Sharma, Ld. Counsel for applicant / accused **Vishal**.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused that the applicant/accused is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that applicant is in custody since 27.01.2020, investigation has already been completed and no useful purpose would be served by further keeping the accused in custody and prayer is made for grant of bail.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State vehemently opposed the bail application and argued that the allegations against the applicant / accused are serious in nature and deceased died after the two months of the marriage. It is further stated by ld. Addl. PP that this is the third bail application and the second bail application of the applicant / accused was dismissed vide detailed order dated 20.07.2021 and since then, there is no change of circumstance and the present applicant is not maintainable and prayer is made for dismissal of the bail application.

I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicant / accused, Ld. Addl. PP for the State and perused the record carefully.

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The allegations against the applicant / accused are serious in nature, deceased died after the two months of the marriage and material witnesses have not been examined in the present case till date. Moreso, this is the third bail application and the second bail application of the applicant / accused was dismissed vide order of this court dated 20.07.2021 and there is no change of circumstances from the dismissal of the second bail application till date.

Keeping in view the overall facts, gravity and seriousness of the offence, I am not inclined to grant bail to the applicant / accused at this stage and hence, the present bail application of the applicant / accused Vishal stands dismissed.
