The matter is listed for reply and arguments on the application of the plaintiff filed under order VII Rule 14 CPC.

By virtue of the aforesaid application, the plaintiff intends to file on record the order dated 05.07.2023 under section 133 Cr.P.C passed by Sub Divisional Magistrate and acknowledgment receipt dated 03.07.2022. Learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that the documents sought to be placed on record are material and relevant for the just adjudication of the matter and that no prejudice shall be caused to the defendant if the same are taken on record. It is further submitted that refusal to allow the filing of the documents would seriously prejudice the plaintiff's case.

Ld Counsels for the defendants submits that they do not want to file any written reply to the said application and are ready to argue on the same.

Ld Counsel for D2 and D3 have no objections if the said application of the plaintiff is allowed subject to cost.

Ld Counsel for D1 has opposed the said application submitting that no grounds have been mentioned by the plaintiff as to what prevented him from filing the documents initially.

Heard. Considered. Record perused.

I have considered the rival contentions and have carefully perused the record. It is evident that the plaintiff seeks to place on record documents which he considers essential for substantiating his case. Perusal of the file reveals that the matter is still at the infant stage and accordingly, I find no impediment in allowing the application filed by the plaintiff under Order VII Rule 14 CPC. However, the same is subject to payment of costs of Rs. 3000/- to be paid equally to all the defendants (Rs. 1000/- each) on the next date of hearing. ***Application stands disposed of accordingly.***
