Present: Ld. Counsel for the DH along with DH in person.

An application is moved on behalf of the DH seeking permission to break open the lock of suit premises for execution of decree.

Submissions heard. Record perused.

Record reveals that when the warrants of possession were issued, the same could not be executed as there was resistance from the side of the JD that he will not vacate the premises.

In view of the report filed earlier by the Nazir, application is allowed.

Issue fresh warrants of possession with respect to the suit property with permission of police aid, if required, and with further permission to break open the locks of the suit premises in case of any resistance or obstruction from the side of JD.

DH is directed to appear before Ld. ACJ for appointment of Bailiff, on 01.12.2023.
