File taken up today on application U/s. 483 BNSS for seeking grant of regular bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Nitesh Kumar**.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is in JC since 07.12.2025 and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that applicant/accused is an innocent person and he has no specific role attributed in the said FIR and all recovery has made out. It is further submitted that investigating agency has already been extensively investigated the matter when the applicant/accused was in police custody and no incriminating material came on surface during custodial interrogation. It is further submitted that investigation qua applicant/accused has already been completed and no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the applicant/accused behind the bars. It is further submitted that no application of applicant/accused is pending either before any other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly

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opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Briefly stated, the present FIR bearing no. 953/2025 has been registered at PS Jahangir Puri U/s. 310(2) / 311 / 317(3) / 61(2)/3(5) BNS with the allegations that applicant/accused **Nitesh Kumar** alongwith his co-accused persons hatched a criminal conspiracy and in pursuance of the said criminal conspiracy as well as, in furtherance of their common intention, they all committed robbery of cash amounting to Rs. 36 lakhs from the possession of complainant and while committing the aforementioned robbery, they caused multiple stab injuries to the victim. As per the reply of IO, applicant/accused **Nitesh Kumar** has been arrested at the instance of complainant and cash amounting to Rs. 1 lakh was recovered from his possession out of the robbed money amounting to Rs. 36 lakhs. Present case is at initial stage and the charges has not been framed as yet. Further, material witnesses are yet to be examined and releasing

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applicant/accused on bail at this stage may cause threat to the witnesses.

Keeping in view of the above discussion and seriousness of allegations leveled against applicant/accused **Nitesh Kumar** as well as keeping in view of seriousness and gravity of the offence alleged against him, this court is not inclined to grant bail to applicant/accused **Nitesh Kumar**. Bail application is accordingly, dismissed. Copy of order be given dasti to the concerned parties. The present bail application file be tagged with the main case file.
