File taken up today on an application U/s. 439 Cr. P. C for extension of interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Vikram.**

Present: Sh. Pankaj Kumar Ranga, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.
Sh. Raj Kumar Chandiwal, Ld. counsel for applicant/accused.

Ld. counsel for applicant/accused submitted that vide order dated 22.08.2023, this Hon'ble Court was granted the interim bail to applicant/accused on the ground that applicant/accused is suffering from chronic pain in abdominal as well as in his private parts. It is further submitted that applicant/accused release from the judicial custody on 29.08.2023 due to non furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds. It is further submitted that as per order dated 22.08.2023 passed by the Hon'ble Court, applicant/accused was directed to the surrender after the expiry of interim bail i.e. 30.08.2023, however, in view of the circumstances, the period of interim bail of one week will be expired on 30.08.2022 (holiday of Raksha Bandhan) and therefore, the applicant/accused having only one day out of total period of one week of the interim bail. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for state strongly opposed the above said application and submitted that above said application may kindly be dismissed.

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Heard.

Perusal of the record shows that this Court was granted the interim bail for a period of one week (w.e.f 23.08.2023 to 30.08.2023) to applicant/accused on the ground that applicant/accused Vikram for getting himself treated for the aforementioned ailment. As per the submissions of Ld. counsel for applicant/accused that applicant/accused has not been released from judicial custody till date and he could not obtain medical treatment.

Keeping in view of the above, interim bail application of **applicant/accused is extended for a period of one week (i.e. till 06.09.2023)**, on the same terms and conditions vide order dated **22.08.2023**. A Copy of this order be sent to concerned Jail Superintendent and be given dasti to Ld. counsel for applicant.
