On query of the Court, IO submits that despite best efforts made by him to find out the identity of unknown deceased who had sustained fatal injuries in the road accident, same could not be established. He has also pointed out that public notice was also given in two Newspapers in this regard and which are annexed alongwith DAR. His statement has been recorded separately to the effect that whereabouts of the deceased unknown person who had died in the accident, as well as of the particulars of offending vehicle and its driver could not be traced out.

Copy of order dt. 20.03.2026 passed by Ld. JMFC has also been filed alongwith DAR.

In view of statement of IO and the material filed alongwith DAR, the present DAR is accepted as untraced. File be consigned to record room as sine-die. It be revived as and when the whereabouts of the offending vehicle and/ or its driver are traced out. The family members of victim be also informed about the Victim Compensation Scheme, as and when the identity of victim/deceased is established, as per law.
