

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 IN
S.C.C. No. 180697/2025

Perused the record and proceeding. The present case is for the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. On perusal of complaint, it shows that, accused is residing out of territorial jurisdiction of this Court. Section 225 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 provides that, where the accused is residing at a place beyond the area in which magistrate exercises his jurisdiction, the magistrate shall postpone the issue of process against the accused and inquire into the case for the purpose of deciding whether or not there is sufficient ground for proceeding. As the accused is residing beyond territorial jurisdiction of this Court, matter requires inquiry under Section 225 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. In view of this provision, it would be just and appropriate to postpone issuance of process in the present case. Hence, I pass following order-

ORDER

As per Section 225 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the Issuance of process is postponed and matter be kept for inquiry.
