Pankali Vs. Manoj & Ors.

This is an application filed on behalf of the applicant seeking direction to the concerned Bank Manager for release of compensation amount lying in the bank account of her husband Sh. Bhudaiya who has expired on 03.02.2026. Copy of death certificate of Sh. Bhudaiya is also annexed with the present application.

Death verification report of Sh. Bhudaiya received as verified.

Heard on the aforesaid application. Record perused.

It is apparent from the death certificate filed on record that petitioner no. 2 Sh. Bhudaiya has expired on 03.02.2026.

Report from the concerned bank received.

A perusal of the bank report reveals that in the bank account of Sh. Bhudaiya, his son namely Sagar is a nominee. However, there is no nominee in the FD account of deceased Sh. Bhudaiya.

Since, there is no nominee in the FD account of the deceased Budhaiya, his wife namely Pankali(applicant herein), is appointed as nominee being widow of Bhudaiya. She is directed to release the amount lying in the FD account of the deceased Budhaiya in equal proportion to the remaining LRs of deceased including herself, as per rules.

In view of the aforesaid, **concerned bank manager SBI, Rohini Courts Branch, is directed to release the entire amount lying in the bank account of Sh. Bhudaiya to his nominee/son Parmod, after completing necessary formalities, as per rules.** He is further directed to release the entire amount lying in the FD account of the deceased Budhaiya to his wife Smt. Pankali on completing necessary formalities, as per rules. With these directions, present application stands disposed off. Be tagged with main case file. Copy of this order be given dasti.
