Heard.

In case of *Gohar Mohammed Vs. Uttar Pradesh State Road Transport Corporation & Ors. in Civil Appeal No.9322/2022 decided on 15.12.2022*, it has been held that:

In case the claimant(s) or legal representative(s) of the deceased have filed separate claim petition(s) in the territorial jurisdiction of different High Courts, in the said situation, the first claim petition filed by the claimant(s)/legal representative(s) shall be maintained by the said Claims Tribunal and the subsequent claim petition(s) shall stand transferred to the Claims Tribunal where the first claim petition was filed and pending. It is made clear here that the claimant(s) are not required to apply before this court seeking transfer of other claim petition(s) though filed in the territorial jurisdiction of

different High Courts. The Registrar General of High Courts shall take appropriate steps and pass appropriate order in this regard in furtherance to the directions of this Court.

In view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Delhi in case of Gohar Mohammed Vs. Uttar Pradesh State Road Transport Corporation & Others (Supra), **the present DAR be transferred to the concerned Tribunal at District Courts, Badhayu, UP through the office of Ld. Principal District and Sessions Judge, North-West, Rohini, Delhi.**

Parties are directed to appear before the concerned Tribunal at District Courts, Badhayu, UP.
