Harnet Kaur Sethia v. Manjeet Singh

In order dated 26.03.2025, my Ld. Predecessor directed the appellant to deposit 20% of the fine amount in form of FDR in the name of the Court within 30 days from that date, upon which the sentence awarded was to be suspended till disposal of the appeal and the appellant was admitted to bail on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Successor Court/Duty MM. Direction was also for issuance of notice of the appeal to respondent on filing of PF/RC for 15.05.2025.

Again on 15.05.2025, it was observed that the aforesaid FDR was not deposited by the appellant and even steps were not taken on behalf of the appellant to issue notice to respondent in terms of order dated 26.03.2025. Direction in order dated 15.05.2025 was to the appellant to deposit within two working days the aforesaid FDR, failing which copy of order was sent to Ld. Trial Court for taking steps for sending the appellant to Jail for non-compliance of the condition of the bail order dated 26.03.2025. Again, direction was given for filing of PF/RC to appellant for issuance of notice of the appeal to respondent but despite said direction, no steps were taken on behalf of the appellant for compliance of said order dated 15.05.2025 for issuance of notice of appeal to respondent.

Vakalatnama of Sh. Sanjay Sharma, Advocate bears date 17.05.2025. There was no impediment in the way of the Ld. Counsel for appellant in taking steps for issuance of notice to respondent as per above order. Only on 19.05.2025, the FDR of amount of Rs.1,40,000/- was deposited, and it finds mention that the deposit is by Pushpa Setia and not by the appellant.

Another opportunity is sought for compliance of previous orders of this court in letter and spirit.

Subject to cost of Rs.2000/- to be deposited in Prime Minister National Relief Fund by the appellant in two working days time period and compliance of aforesaid orders in two working days time period, another opportunity is given to the appellant for taking steps for issuance of notice of appeal to respondent on filing of PF/RC for **08.08.2025**.

TCR be requisitioned.

Copy of this order be sent to Ld. Trial Court for information and compliance of this order and order dated 15.05.2025.
