*(1) Whether plaintiff granted a loan of Rs. 7 Lacs to the defendant on 16.06.2017 and another loan of Rs. 7 Lacs on 19.07.2018 as claimed by the plaintiff ? **OPP***

*(2) Whether defendant issued cheque bearing no. 062834 dated 10.09.2018 and 062835 dated 11.09.2018 both drawn on PNB Burari, Delhi in discharge of aforesaid loan liability? **OPP***

*(3) If previous issues are decided in favour of plaintiff what is the amount for which plaintiff is entitled to claim from defendant? **OPP***

(4) Relief.

No other issue arises or pressed for. The counsels appearing for the parties stated that there is no likelihood of the settlement of matter between the parties at this stage, as such, there is no use of referring the parties to adopt ADR means. List of witnesses be filed within 15 days by the parties.
