JUDGMENT

(Delivered on 21/10/2022)

The particulars of the offences were read over and explained to the accused in Marathi language. Thereafter, the accused has submitted that he does not claim to be tried and has pleaded guilty. He has also filed a pursis at Exh. 02 to that effect. I have explained to him the following things :-

- a) That the offence under section 283 of the I.P.C. is punishable with fine which may extend to two hundred rupees.
- b) That if he pleads guilty he would waive his right to trial.
- c) That he is not bound to plead guilty and if he does so, he will have a conviction on his record.
- d) That if he pleads guilty, there shall be no appeal.

[2] However, even after making the accused aware of the consequences of his pleading guilty, he has remained firm on his plea. Thus, I am satisfied that the accused has pleaded guilty voluntarily and upon fully understanding the consequences of it. The plea made by the accused is therefore, genuine. Hence, I accept his plea and convict him for the offences punishable u/s. 283 of the I.P.C..

[3] Heard the accused on point of sentence. It is submitted that he has committed the offences for the first time and he would not repeat commission of such offences in future.

Therefore, it is prayed that he may be treated leniently. Considering the facts and circumstances of the present case, the nature of offence committed by the accused and the submission made by the accused on the point of sentence, I am inclined to sentence the accused with fine in the amount of Rs.200/-. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order :-

:- ORDER :-

- i) The accused **Ankush Jankiram Dhadare** is convicted for the offences punishable under section 283 of the Indian Penal Code vide Section 252 of the Criminal Procedure Code.
- ii) The accused **Ankush Jankiram Dhadare** is sentenced to pay fine of Rupees **200/-** and in default to suffer simple imprisonment for 3 days, in respect of the offence punishable under section 283 of the Indian Penal Code.
