1. In the present matter the *withdrawal pursis* is given vide Exhibit- . The plaintiff has stated that talks of settlement has been going on between the parties and therefore the *withdrawal pursis* has been produced. The plaintiff has admitted his signature over the *pursis*. It is well settled principle of law that the suit can be withdraw by the parties after according reasons for it and after the satisfaction of the Court.
2. Looking to the *withdrawal pursis* given vide Exhibit- and the principle laid down by the Law, the reasons accorded in the present *withdrawal pursis* are satisfactory to this Court and hence the suit is allowed to be withdrawn unconditionally and hence stands disposed of.
3. No order as to costs.
4. Refund certificate be issued in the name of plaintiff as per rules.
