Submissions heard. From the pleadings of the parties following issues have arisen:-

1. Whether the plaintiff has suffered any loss due to the act of defendant no. 1 to 3, as alleged? OPP
2. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to decree of Rs. 8,67,500/- as claimed? OPP
3. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to decree of permanent injunction restraining the defendants no. 1 to 3 from raising any illegal and unauthorized construction over suit property, personally or through their agents etc, as claimed? OPP
4. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to decree of mandatory injunction thereby directing the defendant no. 4 to stop and remove /

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demolish the illegal and unauthorized construction as raised by remaining defendants over the suit property and to take appropriate legal actions in this regard? OPP

5. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to interest on the damages, if so, at what rate and for which period? OPP

6. Relief.

No other issue arises or pressed for.
