DHARMENDRA TRIPATHI Vs. STATE

1. This is an application under Section 483 BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail, moved on behalf of applicant Dharmendra Tripathi.

2. It is submitted by ld. Counsel for applicant/accused that applicant/accused has no connection with the co-accused and no contraband has been recovered from the accused. It is submitted that notice u/s 67 of NDPS has been served to the accused, however, no date has been mentioned in the same. It is submitted that applicant has not been mentioned in the FIR and co-accused had disclosed the name of the present applicant. It is further submitted that applicant/accused is seeking anticipatory bail of accused Dharmendra Tripathi.

3. On the other hand, ld. Addl. PP has opposed the application stating that allegations are very serious. It is submitted that on the instructions of one Dharmender, applicant transferred collected money from selling smack and cocaine in the account of Pushkar. It is submitted that applicant Pushkar Pandey, Om Prakash, Jay Vivek and Dharmender are involved in the nexus of drugs selling in Delhi and NCR.

4. Heard. Perused.

5. Today, IO has brought the bank account details of the applicant which reflects continuous payments from the main accused Om Prakash. Though on the last date of hearing, there was contrary submission on behalf of IO. The payments are on frequent basis sometimes even twice or thrice in a day. Therefore, prima facie the possibility of applicant being involved in the deals of contraband substance with the co-accused Om Prakash cannot be ruled out. Therefore, no ground is made out to grant bail to the accused. Application stands disposed off.

6. In view of the recommendations of Rules Committee under Section 523 of BNSS, 2023 with respect to the practice directions issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition no. W.P.(C) 1082/2022 Suhash Chakma Vs.
