1. This is an application under Section 483 BNSS for grant of regular bail, moved on behalf of applicant Bikash Kumar.

2. It is submitted by ld. Counsel for applicant/accused that applicant/accused had been in JC since 23.01.2026. It is submitted that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is submitted that no contraband has been recovered from the possession of the accused and applicant is having clean and clear antecedents and applicant belongs to Bihar and came to Delhi just one month back and is having a young aged of 24 years and has a bright future ahead. It is submitted that applicant was residing in a room sharing with his friend Ashu and said boy Ashu is co-accused. It is submitted that present applicant is working as a labour of loading and unloading as labour of goods/vegetables and is only earning member of his family. It is submitted that there was no CCTV camera installed at their house and there was no eye witness of the alleged raid and no recovery has been effected from his possession.

3. On the other hand, ld. Addl. PP has opposed the application stating

that allegations are very serious. It is submitted that accused is continuously supplying ganja and a total of 31.2678 kg of ganja has been recovered from the accused. It is submitted that CDR of accused has been obtained and all the three person are connected. It is further submitted that applicant/accused may commit the same offence again, if released on bail.

4. Heard. Perused.

5. Both the accused were found from the place where alleged ganja was recovered and also considering the fact that the earlier 10.3 kg ganja is also stated to have been delivered from the place where the accused person was found & the quantity in this way falls in the category of commercial quantity. Hence, no ground is made out for bail, *hence, application seeking regular bail is dismissed.*

6. In view of the recommendations of Rules Committee under Section 523 of BNSS, 2023 with respect to the practice directions issued by Hon'be Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition no. W.P.(C) 1082/2022 Suhash Chakma Vs.
