This is the application for anticipatory bail moved u/s 482 BNSS for the applicant **Pramod Singh**.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for accused/applicant that the applicant received some phone calls from police officials of crime branch thereby directing him to get the documents of his car verified from PS Crime Branch. The applicant got panicked for which he has moved the present application. Copy of RC filed. Original shown.

Reply has been filed. Copy supplied.

It is submitted by SI Yogesh Kumar and Inspector Sandeep that a secret information was received that a syndicate is operational in the area of Etah, UP who used to forge chassis and engine number of stolen vehicles and it was informed that one such vehicle i.e. Scorpio car bearing registration No. UP82AE1555 parked at Swabhiman Apartment, Ashok Vihar. The phone number mentioned on the dashboard of the car was taken and it was instructed to the person who picked phone to get the documents verified but the owner of the car did not come

in the office of PS Crime branch to get the documents verified.

This court has made queries to SI Yogesh Kumar and Inspector Sandeep as to whether there is any written complaint which is answered in negative. It is also asked as to whether any DD entry has been lodged for which the phone calls were made to the alleged suspicious car owner. It is submitted that even no DD entry was lodged. It is also asked as to whether any single document was prepared on the basis of which the alleged inquiry was initiated. It is submitted that there is no document whatsoever.

In these circumstances, the worthy DCP concerned to file report as to under which provision of BNSS the alleged inquiry was initiated without preparing any document or as to whether the police officials of crime branch are immuned from the applicability of BNSS.
