ORDER BELOW EXH.1

[Passed on 28.03.2023]

The present application is filed under the provisions of the Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 for issuance of the heir-ship certificate.

Brief facts are as under,

2. Deceased **Fatteramji Mukaji Maske** was husband of applicant No.1 and father of applicant Nos.2 to 7. Deceased **Fatteramji Mukaji Maske** died on **24/01/2022**. Applicants are only heirs of deceased **Fatteramji Mukaji Maske**. Applicants, lastly, prayed that the legal heir-ship certificate may kindly be issued in their favour.

3. After receipt of the application, paper proclamation and citation notice were issued. Accordingly, citation notice duly published vide report Exh.06 to 08 respectively.

4. Applicant No.3 has filed his evidence affidavit at Exh.11. He stated on oath that his father **Fatteramji Mukaji Maske** died on **24/01/2022**. Applicants are legal heirs of deceased **Fatteramji Mukaji Maske**. Applicants have filed death certificate of deceased **Fatteramji Mukaji Maske** at Exh. 12. It appears that deceased **Fatteramji Mukaji Maske** died on **24/01/2022**. Applicants have filed copy of Adhar cards at Exh.13 to 18 and 22. Applicants have filed copy of News paper "Vruttkeshri", dtd.08.02.2023 at Exh.19. The public notice was published in the said news paper.

5. In spite of publication of citation notice and Paper publication, nobody has taken objection to the present application.

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Therefore, on the basis of oral evidence of applicants No.3, it reveals that applicants are only legal heirs of deceased **Fatteramji Mukaji Maske**.

6. Considering the above said discussion, the application deserves to be allowed. In the result, I proceed to pass following order:-

ORDER

- (1) The application is allowed.
- (2) Issue heirship certificate in the name of applicants recognizing them as legal heirs of deceased **Fatteramji Mukaji Maske**.
- (3) The application is disposed of accordingly.
