1. This is an application u/s.483 BNSS moved on behalf of the applicant / accused **Birmand @ Madu** s/o Vijay Singh for grant of regular bail.
2. Reply has been filed on behalf of the IO. Same is taken on record. Copy supplied.
3. Ld. Counsel for the accused submits that the accused has been falsely implicated in this case and is in JC for long. It is submitted that applicant went to Kumar Sweets to have parantha, where main accused Sandeep compelled him to sit in the car on gun point. It is submitted that the applicant is innocent. It is submitted that the applicant shall abide by all the conditions, if he be granted bail.
4. Ld. Addl. PP for the state opposes the bail application by submitting that the allegations against the applicant are serious in nature.
5. I have heard rival submissions and carefully perused the record.
6. As per the report of the IO, a PCR call regarding abduction and firing was received on 03.02.2026 vide DD No.12A. It was reported by the complainant that he was going to his house in Breeza car but was stopped by five persons who overpowered him on gun point and abducted him in the

car. The car of the complainant was driven in the nearby area and two bullets were fired in different localities by one of those boys.

7. The applicant was arrested on identification of complainant. The co-accused Sandeep @ Mental is yet to be arrested and weapon of the offence is still not recovered. The manner in which the complainant was abducted and bullets were fired in area creates panic in the society. There are chances that the complainant will be threatened by the applicant, if he be released on bail.
8. Accordingly, no ground for bail is made out and **the present application is hereby dismissed.**
9. It is clarified that nothing mentioned hereinabove shall tantamount to expression of opinion on merits of this case.
10. Copy of this order be given to Ld. Counsel for the accused. Copy be also sent to accused through Superintendent of jail concerned as well as IO/SHO concerned for information through Bail Section.
