STATE NCT OF DELHI Vs. JANE ALAM

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.

1. This is bail application under Section 483 BNSS for grant of bail, moved on behalf of applicant/accused Jane Alam.

2. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused that the investigation on the part of applicant is complete and accused is no more required for any purpose. It is submitted that nothing has been recovered from the accused and applicant belongs to poor strata and is doing labour work and is sole bread earner of his family. It is submitted that applicant undertakes to abide by terms and conditions and is ready to furnish sound surety if granted bail.

3. It is submitted by the Ld. Addl. PP for the State that as per report of IO, applicant is arrested red-handed with 47.90 gms of smack (heroin) which was recovered from his possession and recovery clearly establishes his involvement of commission of offence. Investigation is still pending and if applicant be released on bail, he may tamper with investigation & influence witnesses. Hence, submitted that the bail be dismissed.

4. Heard. Perused.

5. Considering the fact that the applicant/accused has not been previously involved in any other offence and investigation is complete and also that the quantity recovered from applicant is intermediate and considering the totality of facts and circumstances and apprehension of State, I am of the view that no purpose will be served by keeping the applicant/accused in custody. Therefore, the application is allowed. Applicant/accused is admitted to bail on furnishing personal bond in sum of Rs. 10,000/- with one surety of the like amount subject to the conditions that:

(a) Applicant/accused shall not commit the same offence again & must not threaten the witnesses;

(b) Applicant/accused shall provide his fresh address by way of an affidavit in the Court after his release and in case of any change in his address shall inform the Court;

(c) Applicant/accused shall appear on each and every date of hearing before the Court.

6. Application stands disposed off. Copy dasti. Copy of this order be also sent to Jail Superintendent.
