Summons have been served upon the defendants and written statement on behalf of defendants alongwith authority letter issued by the Ld. Secretary of the DLSA North West in favour of Id counsel Sh. Pradeep Kumar who is present in the matter is filed.

In between the dates of hearing, plaintiff has filed one application under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC seeking amendment in the plaint. Copy of the same is supplied to the counsel for defendant who stated that he is ready to make submissions without any written formal reply.

Submissions are heard on the amendment application.

Initially, suit was filed by the plaintiff mentioning the nature of the subject matter of the suit as commercial before the Commercial Court and after the orders of Ld. District Judge, Commercial Court, North-West the same has been transferred to this court. By way of present application the plaintiff is seeking permission to amend the plaint deleting the paragraph no. 19 in which the nature of the subject matter is mentioned as commercial dispute and paragraph in prayer clause 'i'. Considering the facts that the amendment sought is formal in

nature as such application is allowed. Amended plaint filed is taken on record. It is stated by the counsel for the defendant that no written statement to the amended plaint is required.

As such matter is adjourned for replication, filing of documents in original, their admission/denial, settlement of issues on **05.10.2023**.
