ORDER BELOW BAIL APPLICATION

This is an application for bail moved by the accused under section 480 of the B.N.S.S. in connection with Crime No. 1127/2025 registered with the Dadar Railway Protection Force for the offence punishable under section 143 of the Railways Act.

2. Read the application. Accordingly, the say of Ld. Senior P. P. and the E.O. was called. The E. O. filed his say and objected the application on the ground that if the accused is released on bail he would abscond as he has no fixed place of abode at Mumbai. The accused would also pressurize the prosecution witnesses. Today, the Ld. Senior P. P. is not present in the Court. Hence, this application proceeded with his say.

3. Heard, the Ld. Advocate Shri. B. N. Tiwari for the accused. He submitted that the inquiry has been completed and the E.O. has filed complaint against the accused. The accused was not arrested during the course of inquiry. So, the physical custody of the accused is not required. The accused is ready to abide by each and every condition, which will be imposed by this Court.

4. Having regards to the grounds stated in the application in light of nature and stage of the case, if the bail is granted to the accused subject to certain conditions, no harm or prejudice would be caused to the prosecution. In result thereof, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

1. The Bail application No. 279 of 2025 is allowed and disposed of.
2. Accused namely Subhash s/o Ramnath Mourya be released on bail on his executing P. R. Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with one local solvent surety of the like amount.
3. Accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and shall not make contact with any person known to the facts of the case and attend each and every date of hearing of the present case, till conclusion of trial.
4. The accused shall furnish authenticated copy of his identity and address proof.
5. Accused shall not indulge himself in the same kind of offence here-in-after.
6. Provisional cash bail of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) is granted for Four weeks.
