The present application has been moved under Section 483 BNSS, 2023 for grant of regular bail for applicant/accused Bhavesh Kumar.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused has submitted that no similar application of the applicant/accused is pending before any other court.

Reply already filed. Copy thereof already supplied.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/ accused argued on the lines of bail application. During the course of arguments, Ld. Counsel for applicant/ accused submits that applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case and he has nothing to do with the alleged offence. It is further stated that he has been running in J/C since 30.08.2025. It is further stated that co-accused Deepak @ Judi has already been granted bail. It is further stated that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the accused and if any recovery has been shown from the possession of accused, same has been planted. It is further stated that applicant/ accused is not involved in any other criminal activities. It is further stated that investigation has

already been completed and he is no more required for custodial interrogation. It is prayed that he may be released on bail.

Ld. Addl. PP for State assisted by IO strongly opposed the bail application on the ground that offence is grave and serious in nature. Ld. Addl. PP for State further submits that accused cannot claim parity with the co-accused, as the co-accused could not be identified by the complainant during judicial TIP, whereas the present applicant is named in the FIR. It is further stated that he has many previous involvements and he is a habitual offender.

Submissions heard. Record perused.

Keeping in view the fact that applicant/ accused is named in the FIR and he had shown knife while committing robbery and he has previous involvements in many cases, therefore, no ground is made out to allow the application. **Hence, the application stands dismissed.**
