TPDDL Vs. Anjum & Anr.

Present: Sh. Satish Kumar, AR for the complainant, along with Sh. Vaibhav Gupta, Manager & Ms. Shiwani Sharma, Sr. Manager Legal for TATA Power Delhi Distribution Ltd.

Both accused persons, namely, Anjum and Muskaan in person.

It is submitted by both accused persons that due to their financial conditions, they are not in a position to engage counsel in the instant matter. Accordingly, they have requested to provide legal aid counsel.

Dy. LADC-Sh. Sanjay Hooda is present in the court. He is requested to assist the accused persons. Accordingly, bail application is filed by Ld. Dy. LADC.

Submissions of Ld. Dy. LADC heard.

The present case is U/S 135 r/w Section 150 of the Electricity Act. The case is based upon the documentary evidence. Trial of this case will take its own time. **Considering all these facts, both the accused persons are admitted on bail on furnishing their personal bonds and the surety bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/- each.**

Personal bonds have been furnished and the same are hereby accepted till the next date of hearing.

Ld. Dy. LADC seeks some time to furnish the bail bonds.

The documents have been supplied to Ld. Dy. LADC. Ld. Dy. LADC has gone through the documents. Same are complete.

Submissions on framing of notice heard.

It is submitted by Ld. Dy. LADC for accused persons that accused persons have been falsely implicated in the instant matter and no offence is made out against them.

Per contra, it is submitted by complainant company that prima faice offence under Section 135 r/w Section 150 of Electricity Act is made out against the accused persons as the sufficient material is on record against the accused persons.

As per Section 154 (3) of the Electricity Act, 2003, the special court may, notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1) of section 260 or section 262 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, try the offence referred to in (sections 135 to 140 and section 150) in a summary way in accordance with the procedure prescribed in the said Code and the provisions of section 263 to 265 of the said Code shall, so far as may be, apply to such trial.

Accordingly, notice U/S 135 r/w Section 150 Electricity Act is framed qua both above mentioned accused persons to which they pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.
