**(Order on bail application of accused Jogeshwar Jha and  
Gautam Jha )**

06.06.2026.

These two applications u/s 483 BNSS have been moved on behalf of applicant / accused Jogeshwar Jha and Gautam Jha for grant of bail. Two separate replies to the said applications have already been filed by IO SI Rakesh.

Arguments have been addressed by Sh. Dinesh Kumar Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor and Sh. Gautam Gupta, Ld. counsel for applicant / accused.

The allegations against the applicants / accused Jogeshwar Jha and Gautam Jha are that on 22.11.2025 at about 6.00 PM, they along with their co-accused Vikas, wrongfully restrained and assaulted the complainant Rahul Agrawal and his elder brother Nitin Garg, with *dandas* causing them severe injuries, with such intention or knowledge, and under such circumstances that, if they by that act had caused the death of victim, they would be guilty of culpable homicide not amounting to murder.

Bail has been sought on the ground that the matter has been settled between the parties and that the applicant / accused

Jogeshwar Jha and Gautam Jha as well co-accused Vikas have tendered unconditional apology and that they shall be filing the quashing petition shortly. Copy of MOU dated 07.04.2026 has been filed.

Complainant along with his brother and their counsel appeared before the court on the last date of hearing, and acknowledged the fact that the matter has been settled and they have no objection if applicant / accused Jogeshwar Jha and Gautam Jha are enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, Ld. Prosecutor has opposed the bail application submitting that material witnesses i.e. complainant and his brother are yet to be examined.

Considering all the fact and circumstances of the case and the fact that the matter has been settled between the parties, the present application is allowed and applicants / accused Jogeshwar Jha and Gautam Jha are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.30,000/- each with one surety in the like amount each, subject to the following conditions :

- i) That the applicants/accused will supply their mobile number(s) to the IO of the case, which should be always working.
- ii) That the applicants/accused will not threaten or influence the prosecution witnesses or tamper with evidence or create any sort of impediment in the trial etc.
- iii) That the applicants/accused will not indulge in any anti-social activity.
- iv) That the applicants/accused will not leave

the country without prior permission of the court.

Copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent. Both the bail applications accordingly stand allowed.

As prayed, a copy of this order be given dasti to Ld. counsel for applicant / accused.
