Mohan Prasad Barnwal & Ors Versus State of Jharkhand

The instant Cri. Misc. petition filed on behalf of petitioners namely **1.Mohan Prasad Barnwal 2. Ankush Barnwal and 3. Renu Devi**, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bermo P.S. Case No.48/2026, instituted for the offence u/ss 115(2),118(1), 126(2),117(2),303(2),76,352,351(2),3(5) of BNS Act, pending in the court of Ld.SDJM, Bermo at Tenughat, Copy of the same has already been served to the Ld. Addl. P.P. of the State.

Ld. Counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that earlier the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail vide A.B.P. No. 268/2026 dt.10.07.2026 by this court with direction to surrender before the Court below within 15 days of receipt of this order, but the petitioner got serious illness suffering from Typhoid and the doctor vide Medical Certificate dated 09.07.2026 advised for bed rest for a minimum 15 days from the date of diagnosis, so, he could not surrender within stipulated time, so the extension petition is filed before this Court. Prayer has been made to extend the time of surrender in the order passed in A.B.P. No.268/2026 with respect to the above petitioner.

Learned Addl. P.P. does not oppose the prayer of the petitioner.

Heard both sides and perused the LCR, case record of A.B.P. No. 268/2026 and from perusal of the same, it appears that earlier the petitioners namely **1.Mohan Prasad Barnwal 2. Ankush Barnwal and 3. Renu Devi**, were granted anticipatory bail by this court on 10.07.2026 in connection with Bermo P.S. Case No.48/2026, but in the light of said order accused persons could not furnished their bail bond before the ld. Court below.

In view of the submissions as made by the Ld. Counsel of the petitioners, the instant Cri. Misc. Petition is hereby allowed and petitioner are directed to surrender before the court below positively

within **one week** from the receipt of this order and in the event of his surrender or arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing his bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court, subject to conditions laid down u/s 482, BNSS. and as such, order dt. 10.07.2026 passed in A.B.P. No.268/2026 is modified to this extent for the petitioners namely **1.Mohan Prasad Barnwal 2. Ankush Barnwal and 3. Renu Devi.**

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Court below for information and needful.
