REGULAR BAIL APPLICATION

O R D E R

This order of mine shall dispose of an application filed by applicant Gagandeep Singh alias Gaggi under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in the aforesaid F.I.R.

2. It is pleaded that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case whereas he has committed no offence. It is pleaded that no offence or occurrence took place on 14.06.2022 between 1: 05 p.m. to 1:20 p.m. The ingredients of Section 8 of Arms Act are not made out against the applicant. Challan has already been presented, as such no

purpose would be served by keeping the applicant behind the bars. The applicant is ready to furnish the bail bonds and will abide by all the terms and conditions of the bail order. Accordingly, he has payed for grant of regular bail.

3. Upon notice, learned Addl. P.P. for State appeared, but did not file any reply, however, opposed the bail application at bar.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant, learned Addl. P.P. for State and have gone through the record of the case.

5. Facts of the case in nutshell are that on 14.06.2022 ASI Surinder Singh alongwith other police personnel was present at Old Tax Barrier, Balongi where SI Sharanjit Singh was also joined in the police party. At about 1:05 p.m. a secret information was received by ASI Surinder Singh to the effect that Gagandeep Singh alias Gaggi and Gurpreet Singh alias Gopi who have relations with Goldi Brar alias Satinderjit Singh resident of Canada and member of gangster 'Laurence Bishnoi Group' are bringing arms and ammunition from Madhya Pradesh for supply to the criminal in the area of Mohali and today as per direction of Goldy Brar, Gagandeep Singh and Gurpreet Singh are coming in a scorio car bearing registration No. HR-25-C-4845 with huge quantity of arms and ammunition and they are coming from Dara Studio towards Jujhar Nagar. If barricades are laid, they can be apprehended. The information being believable ruqa was sent and thereafter nakabandi was laid as per disclosed place. During nakabandi the vehicle scorio was

intercepted from where Gagandeep Singh and Gurpreet Singh were apprehended and from possession of Gagandeep Singh one pistol alongwith 3 cartridges and from possession of Gurpreet Singh one pistol and 4 cartridges were recovered. They could not produce any permit or licence and as such they were arrested. During further investigation, it was established that they are members of the gang of Laurance Bishnoi and had been bringing arms and ammunition at the asking of Goldi Brar member of Laurance Bishnoi group.

6. Counsel for the applicant argue that offence under Section 8 of Arms Act has been wrongly added. There is no evidence of applicant being member of alleged crime syndicate. The applicant is in custody since 14.6.2022. The only one 32 bore pistol and three cartridges alleged to have been recovered from the applicant. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial would take sufficient time, therefore, the applicant should be granted regular bail. The learned Addl.P.P. on the other hand argued that there was specific information that accused was member of the crime syndicate. One main member namely Goldy Brar is in Canada and couldnot be arrested. The pistol and cartridges were recovered from the applicant and his co-accused Gurpreet Singh as per secret information. The allegations against the applicant are serious and there are about 5 other cases against the applicant. The applicant may flee away from the process of law if released on bail. He has prayed for dismissal of the bail application.

7. Now in this case there was secret information that applicant, Gurpreet Singh alias Gopi and Satinderjit Singh alias Goldi resident of Canada are members of crime syndicate. The applicant alongwith Gurpreet Singh was apprehended from scorio car. One pistol and three cartridges were recovered from the applicant while one pistol and 4 cartridges were recovered from co-accused Gurpreet Singh. As per reply filed by DSP before the Hon'ble High Court there were five other cases against the applicant under various offences including under Section 307 IPC which shows the involvement of the applicant with crime syndicate and it cannot be said that no offence under Section 8 of Arms Act is made out. The allegations against the applicant are very serious. There is every possibility that accused/applicant may abscond or interfere with the investigation if released on bail. In view of the same, the bail application filed by the applicant is hereby dismissed. Police record be returned. File be consigned to the record room.
