SHRI RAM Vs. Municipal Corporation of Delhi

Ms. Shivani Vasan, AR of the management.

Reply/calculation sheet has been filed by the management along with receipt of cost of Rs. 1000/- deposited in the DLSA, RADC, New Delhi file.

AR of the management has submitted that its employee Late Smt. Baby had expired on 19.07.2025 due to illness in Sanjeevan Medical Research Ltd, Ansari Road, Darya Ganj, Central Delhi 110002, before joining the management on the regular post of Regular Safai Karamchhari. She has stated that claimant is not entitled to any arrears from management as she had expired before joining the management as regular employee of the management.

At this stage, AR of the applicant (husband of Late Smt. Baby) has submitted that he wishes to withdraw the present application as the present application is not maintainable u/s 33-C (2) of Industrial Dispute Act because the claim of the deceased claimant Smt. Baby has not been adjudicated as reference u/s 10 of ID Act. He has prayed that he may be allowed to withdraw the present application u/s 33-C (2) of Industrial Dispute Act as not maintainable. Separate statement of AR of the applicant has been recorded to this effect.

Submissions heard. Record perused.

Apparently, it was well within the knowledge of both the parties that deceased employee Late Smt. Baby had expired on 19.07.2025, before joining the management as regular employee and that present application u/s 33-C(2) of ID Act was not maintainable, but had continue to pursue the present application.

Thus, applicant has not only deliberately abused the process of law with malafide intention, but also wasted precious time of Court.

Therefore, for the foregoing reasons, present application u/s 33-C(2) of ID Act filed by the applicant stands dismissed as withdrawn as not maintainable, subject to cost of Rs. 5000/- for filing such frivolous application and abusing process of law. Applicant has prayed for time to deposit the cost of Rs. 5000/- in DLSA, RADC, New Delhi.
