ORDER

1. This petition has been filed u/s. 167 (ii) Cr.P.C. seeking statutory bail.
2. Heard. Entire records perused.
3. On perusal of records, this petitioners/accused were arrested in this case for the offences u/s. 120 (B), 406, 420 of I.P.C. and remanded to judicial custody on **21.10.2022**. The petitioners are in judicial custody for the past **61 days**. The respondent police has not filed the **Final Report** till date. **Hence, right is vested upon the accused to be released on statutory bail.** Under these

circumstances, this court is inclined to enlarge the accused on statutory bail subject to following conditions.

i. The petitioners/accused shall execute a personal bond for Rs.25,000/- [Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only] each on their own along with two other sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of this court. The sureties should be the family members of the petitioners/accused.

ii. The petitioners/accused shall appear and sign before the respondent police daily twice at 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. until further orders.
