Jora Singh Vs. State of Punjab

As per the version of HC Gurtej Singh, No.1788/SGR 5 Kilograms of poppy Husk were recovered from the spot but the accused had escaped from the said place whereas the plea on behalf of applicant is that he was holding the conscious possession of the said contraband, since he was not apprehended at the spot with the contraband. Only 5 Kilograms of Poppy Husk is claimed to have been recovered from the spot. Applicant intends to join the investigation but he is facing apprehension of his arrest.

The parties are having rival contentions in this case. Recovery has already been effected. Criminal liability of the applicant would only be assessed when he would join the investigation with the Police, thereafter, the Police would be able to arrive at a conclusion as to whether the applicant was involved in the commission of alleged offence or not. So under these circumstances applicant is directed to join the investigation with the Police and in the event of arrest, he be admitted to interim bail subject to satisfaction of Arresting/Officer with further condition as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and report of Investigation Officer in this regard be called for 30.10.2018.
