ORDER

Record received. Arguments heard.

2. It is mentioned in the application that the accused/applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the above noted case. It is further averred that prosecution allegations are totally false and concocted and nothing has been recovered from the accused/applicant, whereas the police has shown the false recovery from him. It is further averred that accused/applicant is in judicial custody and undertakes to abide by the terms and conditions, as such, he may be granted regular bail.

3. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant while arguing in the lines of the application contended that application may be allowed and accused may be granted bail.

4. Conversely, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the

State submitted that accused/applicant has committed serious offence and as such he does not deserve the benefit of bail and application may kindly be dismissed.

5. Having heard the arguments, it has transpired that accused was arrested on 30.3.2018 from whom 1 kilogram Ganja was recovered. Report of Chemical examiner in the present case is yet to be received, presentation of challan and conclusion of trial shall take considerable long time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/applicant behind bars for indefinite period, as such, accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. Accordingly, bail application is allowed. Record be returned and bail application papers be consigned to the record room.
