ORDER

1. This is the bail application filed on behalf of accused Nos. 1 and 2 who are alleged to have committed offences u/s 323, 324, 326, 201 r/w 34 of IPC.
2. The allegation in the case is as follows: The accused in furtherance of their common intention to cause grievous injury and hurt to the defacto complainant, on 03/09/2022 at about 7.30 pm at Pattom Plamoodu Bhagom, the 1st accused kicked down the defacto complainant and the 2nd accused inflicted a cut on his left elbow with a chopper which is a dangerous weapon. Meanwhile, the 1st accused attempted to cut on his head with a chopper which is a dangerous weapon and it was defended by the defacto complainant with both hands and thereby he sustained a deep injury on the right palm including severance of vein. The accused also inflicted a cut injury to his right thumb. When defacto complainant's friend Abi came running to the spot, the 3rd

accused stabbed him with some dangerous weapon. The accused are thereby alleged to have committed the aforesaid offences.

3. The accused surrendered before this court on 11/07/2023 and they were remanded to judicial custody. Investigation is completed and final report is filed.
4. Heard both the sides.
5. The only point that arises for consideration is whether the petition is to be allowed.
6. The point : Since the investigation is complete I am satisfied that further detention of accused in custody is not necessary. Hence, the accused / petitioners are granted bail however subject to the following stringent conditions.
7. In the result, the CMP is allowed and the bail is granted as follows:
 1. The accused Nos. 1 and 2 shall execute bond for Rs.50,000/- each with two solvent sureties each for the like sum.
 2. They shall not get involved in any other offences while on bail.
 3. They shall not directly or indirectly contact, influence or intimidate the defacto complainant or the other injured in any manner.
 4. They shall not influence or intimidate any person familiar with the facts of the case or tamper with evidence.
 5. They shall not leave the State of Kerala without the prior permission of this court.
 6. Any violation of any of the above conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.
