It is submitted by the accused that she engaged a private
counsel in the instant matter and she requests that LAC may be
discharged in the instant matter.

**In view of the same, Ld. LAC Ms. Asha Jyoti Arya
stands discharged in the instant matter.**

Submissions on framing of notice heard.

It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the accused that
accused has been falsely implicated in the instant matter and no offence
is made out against her.

Per contra, it is submitted by complainant company that
prima faice offence under Section 135 of Electricity Act is made out
against the accused as the sufficient material is on record against the
accused.

As per Section 154 (3) of the Electricity Act, 2003, the
special court may, notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1)
of section 260 or section 262 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973,

try the offence referred to in (sections 135 to 140 and section 150) in a summary way in accordance with the procedure prescribed in the said Code and the provisions of section 263 to 265 of the said Code shall, so far as may be, apply to such trial.

Accordingly, the notice U/S 135 Electricity Act is framed qua the accused. She pleads not guilty and claims trial.

Put up for confirmation of bail and P.E. on **16.05.2024**.
