Accused Lalit, Manoj and Rajbala on court bail.

Proceedings qua accused Saurabh have already been abated.

Sh. S.S. Sachdeva, Adv., for all three accused.

Heard on the point of charge and perused the record.

ORDER ON CHARGE

As per the evidence collected, on 04.07.2020 Manoj brought his bicycle for repair to the shop of Suraj Bhan. Suraj Bhan repaired the cycle and the same was taken away by Lalit, brother of Manoj. After some time, Manoj came back and asked for the cycle. Suraj Bhan told him that his brother had already taken it away. On the same day at about 8 PM, Manoj along with his brothers Lalit and Saurabh and their mother Rajbala armed with dandas reached the shop of Suraj Bhan. Saurabh and Manoj started assaulting Suraj Bhan with dandas. When Renu and her mother tried to save him, they also assaulted Renu and torn her wearing clothes to outrage her modesty and disrobe her.

2. After considering the evidence collected during investigation, in my opinion, prima facie offence punishable **u/s.308/34 IPC** is made out against all the accused persons for assaulting Suraj Bhan. As they have also assaulted Renu, therefore, prima facie offence punishable **u/s.323/34 IPC** is made out against them. As they tried to outrage her modesty and also to disrobe her, therefore, offences punishable **u/s.354 & 354B, both read with Section 34 IPC** are also made out against them. They are charged accordingly, to which they pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

3. **Now to come up for PE on 11.08.2025.** Witnesses Renu, Suraj Bhan alongwith IO and MHC(M) be summoned for that date.
