This petition having been finally heard on 31/07/2024 and the court on the same day delivered the following :-

JUDGMENT

The petitioners seek dissolution of marriage under section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

2. The petition averments are to the following effect :- Petitioners being Hindus solemnized their marriage on 14/09/2015 at Kairali Auditorium, Kottamam, Parassuvaikal Village, as per Hindu rites and ceremonies.

3. They are living separate from 2022 onwards as their marriage is irretrievably broken. They believe that it is not possible for a reunion. So, they have mutually agreed to get their marriage dissolved.

4. Counseling did not materialize in a reunion. On their application this Court waived the period of six months in view of decision reported in ***Amardeep Singh v. Harveen Kaur [2017 (4) KHC 683 (SC)] and in Tomy Joseph v. Smitha Tomy (2018(5)KHC 267).***

5. When the matter came up for consideration, this court enquired the parties about the possibility of a reunion. They expressed their inability for a joint life that there is no possibility.

6. Both parties filed separate affidavits in conformity with the petition averments and marked Ext.A1. Ext.A1 certificate shows the marriage between

the petitioners.

7. From the circumstances it is clear that there is no chance for a reunion of the petitioners. There is no reason to believe that the application is filed fraudulently or by collusion. Hence it is found that as mutually consented by the petitioners, wife and husband, it is feasible to have the marriage between them dissolved.

Hence the marriage between the petitioners is hereby dissolved.
