1. Matter is today fixed for report of filing of written statement/replication/affidavit of admission/denial of documents and for admission/denial, framing of issues and case management hearing. However, no W.S. has been filed.

2. Hard copy of Memo of Appearance on behalf of defendants no.1 & 2 has been filed.

3. Some more time is sought to file the Vakalatnama and W.S.

4. Let the defendants to file W.S. alongwith statement of truth and affidavit of admission/ denial of documents within the statutory period from the date of service alongwith appropriate application for delay condonation with supply of advance copy to opposite party at least one week before the next date of hearing, failing which a costs of Rs.10,000/- shall be deposited with DLSA, Central District.

5. Subject to receiving the copy of the written statement, plaintiff to file replication, if any, and affidavit of admission/denial of documents on or before the next date of hearing with supply of advance copy thereof.

6. Pre-mediation sitting is held from the data base of this Court to identify the matters for the purposes of mediation. It is

submitted on behalf of the parties that they are willing to compromise the present matter.

7. It is further submitted on behalf of the parties that matter may be referred to the Mediation Cell.

8. Heard. This Court is of the opinion that there is element of settlement between the parties and matter can be referred to the Mediation Cell.

9. Vide Circular bearing No. 9743-9943/DMC/THC/Delhi dated 07.02.2026, it has been communicated that vide letter bearing no.45/DMC/Gaz/G-4/2026 dated 07.01.2026, a **Mediation for the Nation 2.0'** campaign is being launched by National Legal Services Authority (NALSA) in association with Mediation and Conciliation Project Committee (MCPC), Hon'ble Supreme Court of India across the country and as such a 90 days intensive drive shall be commencing w.e.f. 02.01.2026 to settle the pending cases through the process of Mediation. Therefore, it has been communicated that for the purpose of referring the suitable cases from database may be identified and to refer the same before Ld. Mediation Cell.

10. Accordingly, the present matter is referred to Mediation with following schedule:-

- a) *The first date of Mediation would be 24.02.2026 at 2.00 PM before the Mediation Centre, THC, Delhi. Both the parties are directed to appear accordingly.*

11. Referral form/ consent form duly signed on behalf of the plaintiff is obtained and be annexed alongwith the file.

12. **As prayed, be put up for report of settlement failing which for report of filing of written statement/ replication/ affidavit of admission/denial of documents and for admission/denial, framing of issues and case management hearing on 09.03.2026.** Parties/AR shall remain present for admission/denial of documents. The proof of supply of advance copy of the pleadings be also filed alongwith the pleadings.

13. It is made clear that referring of the matter to the mediation cell shall not be a ground to seek extension in filing of the written statement.
