1. **This application u/s.483 BNSS 2023 has been moved on behalf of applicant / accused Hirdesh for seeking regular bail. Applicant is facing allegations for the offences u/s.307 IPC.**
2. Ld. Counsel for the applicant / accused has submitted that no similar application is pending before any other Court.
3. Reply filed. Copy supplied.
4. During the course of arguments, Ld. Counsel for the applicant has submitted that the allegations against the applicant are that on 02.08.2023, at about 8.00 p.m., he caused grievous injuries on the neck of the complainant Kishan with a sharp edged weapon. Ld. Counsel has submitted that to prove its case, prosecution has cited 14 witnesses. Out of those 14 witnesses, there are only 3 public witnesses. Those 3 public witnesses have already been examined. The remaining witnesses are formal in nature and there is no reason that the applicant shall threaten them or cause any harm to them. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that the trial of the matter shall take some more time and keeping in applicant in JC during this period shall not serve any purpose.

5. Ld. Addl. PP has strongly opposed the bail application, stating that the allegations against the applicant are serious in nature.
6. Submissions heard. Record perused.
7. Perusal of record would reveal that the prosecution has placed reliance upon 3 public witnesses, who have already been examined. Remaining witnesses are formal in nature. This Court believes that now applicant has no reason to threaten them. Accordingly, there is no reason to keep the applicant further in JC. **The present application is allowed.** Applicant / accused **Hirdesh** be released on bail on furnishing personal bond of Rs.25,000/- with surety of like amount, subject to the condition that he shall not try to influence any of the witnesses of this case and shall attend the trial regular.
8. It is clarified that nothing observed hereinabove shall have any bearing on the merits of the case.
9. The application stands disposed of accordingly.
