Proceedings against accused Dinesh Dabas have
already been abated.
Accused Nitin and Geeta are absent.
Ld. Counsel Sh. Jatin Arora for accused Nitin and Geeta.

Exemption application moved on behalf of both accused on
the ground that accused Geeta is suffering from illness and accused Nitin is
son of accused Geeta and he is taking care of her. Heard. Exemption allowed
for today only.

PW Insp. Anil Kumar, PW ASI Rajesh Kumar and PW-6
Rahul are present.

Matter is fixed for cross-examination of PW-6 Rahul.

Ld. Counsel for accused persons has pointed out that PW-6
Rahul and PW-7 Sumit are witnesses of the same facts and he had earlier
sought permission to cross-examine them on the same date and that
submission was allowed by this Court vide order dt. 26.11.2024 and
21.08.2023. Ld. Counsel for accused has submitted that cross-examination
of PW-6 Rahul be deferred and same be conducted with PW-7 Sumit.

In view of the submissions made, PW-6 Rahul is discharged
unexamined for today and **he be re-summoned for NDOH.**

PW-7 Sumit is absent. Issue B/Ws in the sum of Rs.5000/-
against PW-7 Sumit for NDOH.

PW Insp. Anil Kumar, PW ASI Rajesh Kumar are discharged
unexamined as no time left.
