There is possibility of compromise and matter is stated to be pending in mediation.

It is submitted by complainant that he has no objection if bail is granted till next date of hearing to facilitate compromise.

In the circumstances, **accused Rizwan is admitted to interim bail on furnishing of personal bond and surety bond of Rs.25,000/- each till 16.01.2026**, subject to the following conditions of bail:

- (i) The applicant shall under no circumstances leave India without prior permission of the Court.
- (ii) The applicant shall appear before the Court as and when required.

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- (iii) The applicant shall not tamper with the evidence during the trial.
- (iv) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- (v) The applicant shall provide his mobile number(s) and keep it operational at all times.
- (vi) In case of change of residential address and/or mobile number, the same shall be intimated to the Court by way of an affidavit.
- (vii) During bail period accused shall maintain good conduct, if he is found indulging in criminal acts of similar nature or heinous offence, his bail may be cancelled.

Nothing mentioned herein shall affect the merits of the case.

Application is disposed of accordingly.
