ORDER

1. This is an application preferred by the applicant/accused for extension of four weeks time for surety compliance.
2. The respondent/state has opposed to the plea of extension of time by filing their written say/objection on overleaf of main application.
3. Perused the application, plea submissions, grounds raised therein coupled with the documents placed reliance by the applicant. Also, perused the written say/objection of respondent/state. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant and the Ld. S.P.P. for respondent/state.
4. Having heard to the rival parties and considered their raised submissions contentions and record availed prima-facie it inclined the applicant/accused seeking the relief of extension of time of Four Weeks for making surety compliance in view of compliance of bail order dated 09.05.2024 passed in Criminal Bail Application No.1059 of 2024 and subsequently, the order dated 30.07.2024 passed in Criminal Miscellaneous Application No.1145 of 2024. It revealed the applicant is already permitted to make surety compliance within a period of Four Weeks by order dated 30.07.2024. However, he is seeking further Four Weeks time for surety compliance. The respondent/state raised the objection that no considerable reason cause ground assigned for extension of time for surety compliance. There is strong possibility of his abscondance. Thus, considering the same I felt that as the applicant showing anxiety to make surety compliance as per bail order. Moreover,

he has already availed the surety certificate. The copy of surety certificate enclosed with main application. Thus, in the circumstance, certainly time required to be extended in view of required surety compliance.

:ORDER:

1. The present Criminal Miscellaneous Application No.1877 of 2024 is hereby allowed and disposed of accordingly.
2. The applicant is permitted to make saddled surety compliance within a period of Four Weeks (04) from the date of this order without fail.
3. The rest of saddled conditions in order dated 09.05.2024 passed in Criminal Bail Application No.1059 of 2024 as well as order dated 30.07.2024 passed in Criminal Miscellaneous Application No.1145 of 2024 shall stand as it is.
4. The respondent/state to take note of this order.
